Sector 411 saw an increase in several crimes this past cycle. There was a 150 percent increase in robberies, a rise from 1 to 4. To the right, I've included tips on how to protect yourself from being a victim of a robbery.

There was also a rise in commercial burglaries, an increase from 0 to 3. None of these incidents appear to be related.

In regards to violent crime, this cycle only 1 person suffered a gunshot wound compared to 4 the previous cycle.

Reminder: While it may take time to warm your car, **DO NOT** leave your cars unlocked and running. Of the 9 theft from motor vehicles last month, it was found 8 vehicles left with the keys running. **This is a preventable crime.**

- Walk only in well lit areas.
- Remain aware of your surroundings.
- Walk in a group.
- If you choose to purchase something online from Craig's List / Let Go (etc) meet the person in a crowded area, like a store parking lot or even a police precinct.
- Keep your valuables out of plain view.
- If someone does try to rob you, drop your valuables and run the opposite direction.


