First Day Early Voting for the March Primary

Richmond, VA – The Office of Elections kicks off the first day of in-person Early Voting for the March Presidential Primary today. Virginia is unique in the sense that the state allows for 45 days, or 6 weeks of Early Voting before each election day.

This upcoming election on Tuesday, March 5, is a Dual Primary, meaning that voters will be asked if they need either a ballot of Democratic or Republican candidates.

The Office of Elections at 2134 West Laburnum Avenue Richmond, VA 23227 will serve as an Early Voting location Monday through Friday, 8:30AM to 5:00PM until the last day of Early Voting on Saturday, March 2.

Two satellite locations will open on Tuesday, February 20 from 8:30AM to 5:00PM, until Saturday, March 2. The two locations include:

- City Hall: 900 East Broad Street Richmond, VA 23219
- Hickory Hill Community Center: 3000 East Belt Boulevard Richmond, VA 23234

All Early Voting locations will also be opened on Saturday, February 24 and Saturday, March 2 from 8:30AM to 5:00PM.

We encourage all eligible voters, including young adults who will be 18 by the November General Election, to register to vote, practice their civic duties, and cast their ballot.
