## 2015 ANALYSIS OF INTERNAL AFFAIRS INVESTIGATIONS

This document contains an analysis of complaints that were received by the Internal Affairs Division in 2015. There was a 55.75% increase in the overall number of complaints/investigations received in 2015 as compared to 2014. During the same period the number of informal complaints/investigations increased 33.33% while there was an 80.65% increase in formal complaints/investigations.

In 2015, the Internal Affairs Division investigated 74 complaints involving allegations of serious misconduct; 23 of these investigations involved possible criminal activity. The other services investigated 94 complaints while 8 incidents were handled informally at the request of the complainant. A total of 87 complaints were received from citizens while the Department initiated 89 investigations.

The Department continues to identify and address policy violations. The below table is a comparison of investigative findings for 2014 and 2015. In 2014, there were 25 policy violations resulting from 68 investigations. In 2015 there were 68 policy violations resulting from 121 investigations. This was an increase in investigations resulting in violations from 36.8% in 2014 to 56.20% in 2015.




