Since December 2019, Caprichia has served as the department's Economic and Community Development Administrator. She provides oversight for the City of Richmond's career stations that serve 18,000+ citizens annually. At the onset of the pandemic, Caprichia led our program's virtual migration, providing participants with uninterrupted access to ongoing career and training opportunities.

Caprichia obtained a Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (VA Tech) and earned a Master of Divinity from the Samuel DeWitt Proctor School of Theology at Virginia Union University.
