# CITY OF RICHMOND DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS LEAF COLLECTION PROGRAM

## Bagged Collection Option

Available October 2, 2023

- Up to 10 bags collected on normal trash day (place bags near supercan)
- Biodegradable bags preferred

## Unlimited Bag Collection Option

(by Sector/Trash Collection Day during November and December)

DPW has divided the city into four sectors for bagged leaves based on trash collection days. During this period, residents may put out an unlimited number of bags for collection.

**Sector 1 - Wednesday Trash Collection**  
All bagged leaves will be picked up between November 1 & November 15

**Sector 2 - Thursday Trash Collection**  
All bagged leaves will be picked up between November 16 & November 25

**Sector 3 - Monday Trash Collection**  
All bagged leaves will be picked up between November 27 & December 9

**Sector 4 - Tuesday Trash Collection**  
All bagged leaves will be picked up between December 12 & December 29

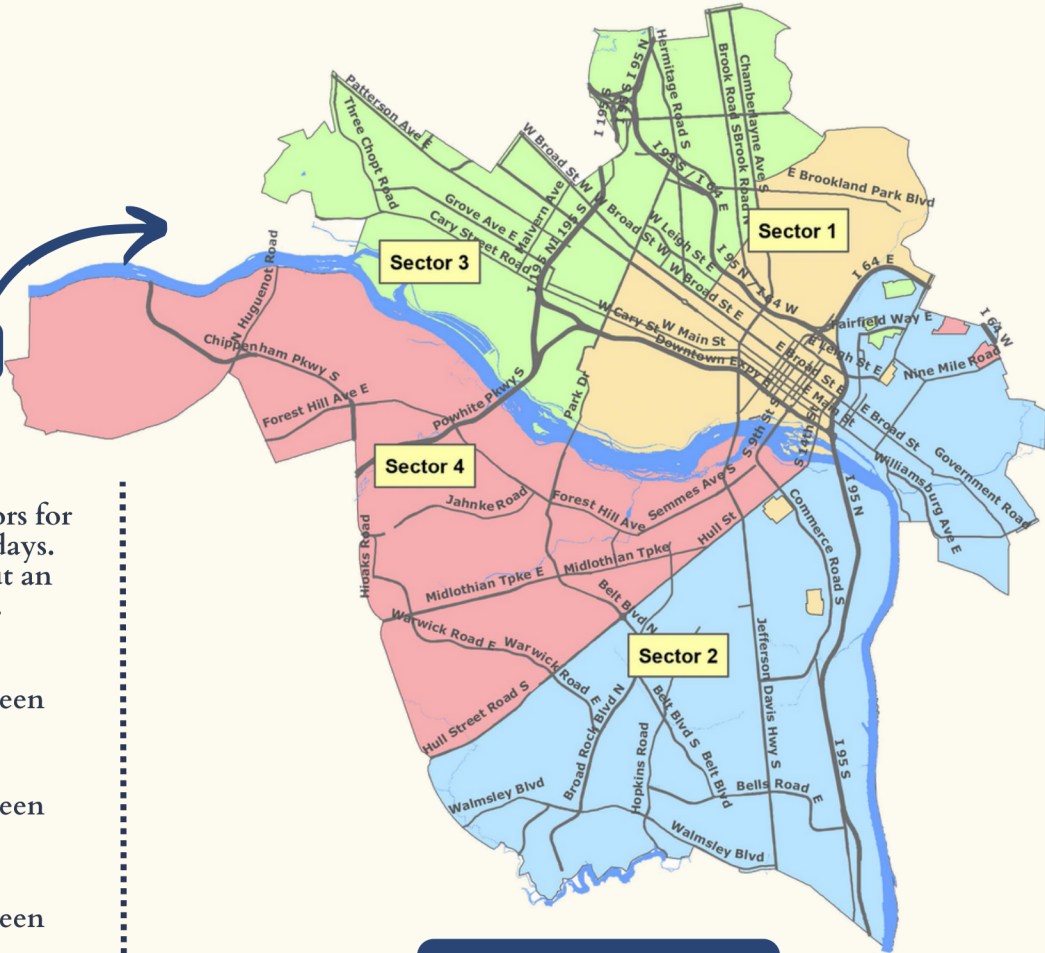
### Dispose of loose leaves:

\*Accepts only loose leaves or leaves in biodegradable bags

**Transfer Station \*\***  
3506 North Hopkins Road (23224)  
\*\*Accepts ALL bagged leaves

### Reminders:

- Make sure leaves are raked to the curb or property line but not into the street or gutter
- Leaves must be raked and ready for pickup when service request is made
- Remove sticks, stones or other objects that may damage equipment
- Leaves will be picked up within 15 days from date of request

Note: vacuum service may be delayed during inclement weather.
