The collaborative effort of our officers and community partners has enabled us to build on last year's crime reduction success. I am pleased to report that year-to-date, we are experiencing historically low numbers for both violent crime and property crime, resulting in a 40 percent reduction in major crime as compared to this period last year. The reductions in thefts from motor vehicles and larcenies, which includes package thefts, are particularly promising. I believe this improvement is a direct result of our partners taking steps to better secure their property.

As spring and warmer weather approach, we must all remain vigilant. Foot traffic in many of our neighborhoods will increase, and tools left in yards and open windows can make your property easy targets for thieves.
