JAIL RESIDENT PASSES AWAY AT HOSPITAL

Richmond, VA—Sheriff C.T. Woody, Jr. announced today that Johnathan Wade Southworth passed away on Saturday, February 4th at VCU Medical Center.

Mr. Southworth was currently being held without bond on a probation violation for a prior Grand Larceny. On February 1, Mr. Southworth was transported to the John Marshall Courthouse where he was to appear before the Court. While in the court holding cell, Mr. Southworth was observed moving freely to and from the restroom area of the cell.

A deputy went to retrieve Mr. Southworth for his court appearance and found him unresponsive. Life saving measures, to include an AED, were begun and medical units responded and Mr. Southworth was transported to VCU Medical Center on February 1.

Mr. Southworth was admitted to the CCU having suffered from cardiac arrest and subsequently passed away on February 4. Next of kin have been notified and the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner is conducting an autopsy.
