RICHMOND SHERIFF'S TRAINING ACADEMY RE-CERTIFIED BY DCJS

RICHMOND, VA—Sheriff C.T. Woody, Jr. today announced that the Richmond City Sheriff's Office (RCSO) Training Center, which conducts mandatory training to certify deputies through its academy, has once again received Re-Certification by the Department of Criminal Justice Services (DCJS).

The RCSO Training Center was initially certified by DCJS in the mid-1980's. Once an agency's initial certification is met, they must undergo an audit every three years to ensure that administrative, operational, and facility standards are maintained for all academies providing mandated training.

The RCSO received the news in the form of a certificate and a letter, dated July 1, 2015, from the Director of DCJS, Francine C. Ecker. The Richmond City Sheriff's Office Training Center's recertification is valid through the end of June 2018.
