8th and Clay Parking Lot to Close Indefinitely

Beginning on or about September 12, 2022, the 8th and Clay off-street parking lot will close indefinitely due to upcoming GRTC construction for the relocation of the passenger transfer station. The Coliseum parking garage will be open to the public 24 hours during weekdays and weekends. The standard rate for the Coliseum is \$5.00 per hour, anything over four hours is considered all-day parking with a rate of \$20.00. Centralized pay stations and mobile payment are both available in the garage.

There is plentiful public off-street parking available nearby, including at 7th, 5th and Main Street Station. Main Street Station offers the opportunity to ride for free the PULSE BRT to the downtown center.
