Meeting Minutes  
June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2026

### **CALL TO ORDER**

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. by Bill Pantele.

Chairman Bill Pantele motioned to adopt the agenda. Secretary Cherlyn S. Stevens seconded the motion. All members were in favor and the motion passed. Introductions were made by all attendees.

### **Approval of Agenda**

### **APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MEETING MINUTES**

No previous meeting minutes were presented for approval at this meeting. Therefore, no action was taken regarding the approval of meeting minutes.

## **OPEN SESSION**

Chairman Bill Pantele made a motion to adopt the agenda as presented all were in favor motion passed.

Early Voting Update – August 4<sup>th</sup> , 2026 Republican Primary

General Registrar David Levine provided an update regarding early voting locations for the August 4<sup>th</sup> , 2026 Republican Primary Election.

Mr. Levine informed the Board that the Hickory Hill Community Center would be unavailable during the early voting period due to previously scheduled summer programming and facility commitments. He recommended maintaining early voting at the Office of Elections and City Hall while suspending the Hickory Hill satellite location for this election.

### **The Board discussed:**

- Historical early voting turnout for Republican-only primary elections.
- Budget considerations and staffing requirements.
- Public accessibility and transportation options.
- Availability of absentee voting and ballot drop box services.
- Security requirements are associated with ballot drop box locations.

### **Board members noted that City Hall remains centrally accessible through Richmond's public transportation network and would continue to serve voters effectively.**

Chair Pantele moved that for the August 4<sup>th</sup> , 2026 Republican Primary:

Early voting will be conducted at:

- Office of Elections (2134 West Laburnum Avenue)
- City Hall satellite location

Hickory Hill Community Center will not serve as an early voting location for this election.

Early voting dates will be:

- Office of Elections: June 18<sup>th</sup> , 2026 – August 1, 2026
- City Hall: July 19<sup>th</sup> , 2026 – August 1<sup>st</sup> , 2026

Sunday voting will be available at both locations on:

- July 19, 2026
- July 26, 2026
- Hours: 12:00 P.M. – 5:00 P.M.

The Registrar will explore expanded ballot drop box availability at City Hall during the early voting period.


The motion was seconded by Madam Chairwoman Joyce K. Smith seconded all were in favor and approved unanimously.

With no further business before the Board, Chairman Bill Pantele adjourned the meeting at 10:17am.


**NEXT MEETING DATE**
