Happy New Year ,

During the month of December, we have seen a decrease in violent crime in Sector 312. Violent crime decreased 53%, 19 crimes in 2017 compared to 9 crimes in 2018. We had:

- 4 - Robbery of Individual (1 Arrest made)
- 1 - Robbery Commercial House(Arrest made)
- 3 - Aggravated Assault
- 1 - Domestic Aggravated Assault (Arrest made)

Property crime increased from 86 to 101 for a 17% increase compared to the same time last year. The biggest increase in property crimes was theft of motor vehicles. We had 30 this month compared to 17 the same time last year. In 27 of the cases, the keys had been left in the vehicle while warming up.

With the weather getting colder please do not leave your vehicle unattended while you let it warm up. This is the easiest way to let a thief steal your vehicle.

Things we can all do to prevent theft from motor vehicles:

- * Lock your car doors
- * Never leave valuables in your vehicle
- * Do not leave change in the open
- * Report anything suspicious to the police.

Things we can all do to prevent Auto Thefts:

- * Remember to lock your car
- * Never leave it running.

In addition to making your property a difficult target the most effective deterrent to these crimes is an active community.

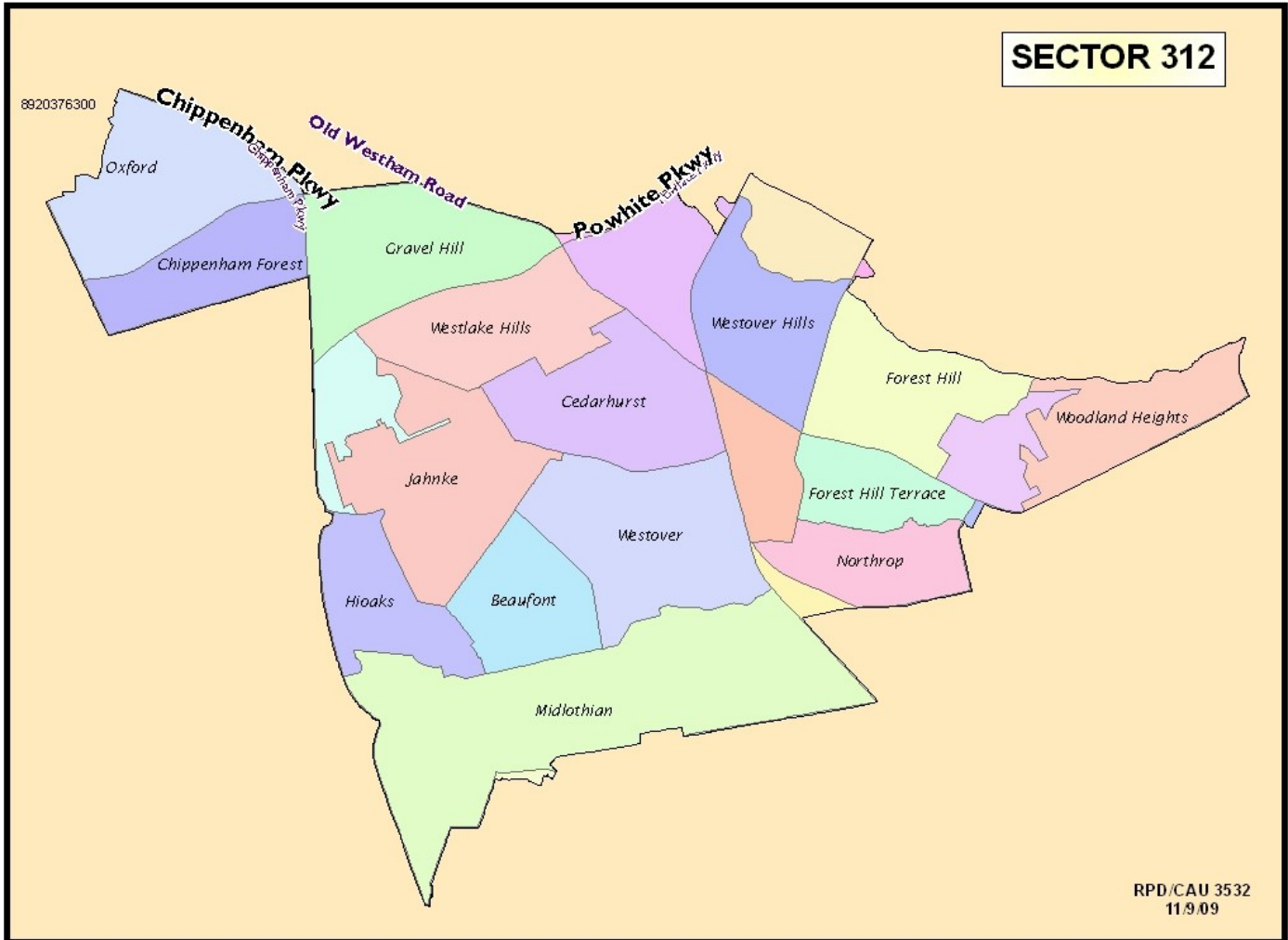
