Sector 411 had an uptick in violent crime this cycle. We went from seven violent crimes to 15 violent crimes including the murder of Leon Chandler, II (see Page 2 for details). That increase is a bit misleading, however, because we had an incident where five officers were working a crime scene when someone fired shots at them. Thankfully, none of the officers were injured, but for reporting purposes we had to report the attempted shooting of the officers as 5 separate crimes.



We are taking significant steps to curb the violent crime in Sector 411, which is currently focused on the Providence Park/ Meadowbridge corridor. We have directed patrol operations with our FMT officers. We are also deploying more patrol officers to these neighborhoods during the key nighttime hours.

Victim Identified in Providence Park Homicide

The Richmond Police Department has identified the victim of this morning's homicide in the Providence Park neighborhood as Leon M. Chandler II, 24, of the 3500 block of Meadowbridge Road.

At approximately 12:15 a.m., officers received a call for a person shot in the 3500 block of Meadowbridge Road. When police arrived, they located **Leon M. Chandler II** outside a residence suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. **Chandler II** was pronounced dead at the scene.


The Medical Examiner will determine cause and manner of death.
