During this 28 Day Cycle, we experienced a 19% increase in major crime. This increase was driven mostly by unusually high increases in violent crime, from 4 to 7 and burglaries from 3 to 9. Fortunately, our precinct officers and detectives were able to make arrests in many of these incidents.
