Fan District Zone 2 RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT APPLICATION

RESTRICTED PARKING DISTRICTS - DEFINITIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

- You must be a resident of the Fan Restricted Parking District to obtain a Fan Parking Decal/Permit or Courtesy Parking Permit. A
 resident is defined as a record owner or renter of property in the district and members of their immediate family who reside with the
 owner or renter at the address in Fan.
- Those renting property in the Fan district must, by ordinance, present a valid, written lease for the property in the Fan District to obtain a permit. Renters are not eligible to purchase Annual Visitor Passes.
- Students must be full-time to meet the residency requirements and comply with the vehicle registration requirements of the Virginia Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). If DMV requires that the vehicle be registered as garaged in the City of Richmond, all City taxes and fees must be paid prior to obtaining a Fan permit.
