New Traffic Signal Installed at Broad Street and Kent Road to Improve Safety ~ Signal temporarily flashing red and yellow ~

RICHMOND, Va. – A new traffic signal has been installed at the intersection of Broad Street and Kent Road. It will be energized on Friday, March 26 and temporarily placed in flash mode. Those approaching from Kent Road will see a red indicator, while those approaching the intersection from Broad Street will see an amber light.

The temporary flashing gives motorists an opportunity to adjust to the new signal ahead of it being set to function as a fully signalized intersection on Monday, April 5.
