Silverwood Drive Drainage Improvement Project

Project Information

This project will reduce the frequency and severity of roadway flooding, backyard pooling, and maintenance costs incurred by the City of Richmond when cleaning the drainage system, resulting in improved drainage capacity and fewer clogs. The improvements will take place primarily on Silverwood Drive and Sweetwood Drive from Hull Street Road to Brittwood Drive.



Project Schedule

Project Assignment: September 2019

Survey & Preliminary Design: Cardinal Survey, February 2020

Engineering Design: Fall 2020 to Spring 2022

Construction Assignment: Fall 2022 through Winter 2022/2023

What Happens Next:

Field Investigations:

Survey or engineering staff and vehicles will be in the neighborhood and project corridor collecting additional data and performing field investigations on occasion to ensure optimal drainage improvements.

Project Duration:

Four to six months, depending on weather conditions. All affected property owners will be notified prior to construction. Lane closures can be expected. We apologize for the inconvenience and greatly appreciate your patience as these important improvements are made.

Improved drainage capacity and few clogs in the drainage system.
