BZA Meetings are held the 1st Wednesday of each month* and begin promptly at 1:00 PM.

Applications shall be processed for docketing with the Board once ALL of the following are submitted:

- Application form (Certificate of Occupancy/Zoning Compliance, building permit, sign permit, etc.)
- Required Documents: Survey**, Floor Plan(s), and Building Elevation(s) and proposed building materials.
 ** = In limited instances, a scaled Site Plan may be permitted at the discretion of the Zoning Administrator.
- Signed "BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS PRESENTATION SUGGESTIONS" document.
- Other information determined by the Zoning Administrator or BZA Secretary, as applicable.
- Required fee.

NOTE: No application for a Special Exception or Variance shall be accepted for review unless the applicant has had a pre-filing conference with a Zoning Administration Staff member.

A \$175.00 fee is required for any application involving single- or 2-family dwellings.

A \$550.00 fee is required for any application involving all other uses.

A \$250.00 fee is required to appeal a decision of the Zoning Administrator.

A \$750 fee is required for any use where a zoning violation resulted from construction that is not in compliance with the approved plans.
