

Update: End of SNAP Replacement Program

Notice: Effective December 21, 2024, the USDA's SNAP Benefits Replacement Program has ended. Our department is no longer able to process claims forms for SNAP benefits replacement. Claims forms that are submitted after December 20th will only be processed if the replacement program is reinstated. Please read the information below for further assistance.

2) If your SNAP benefits were stolen from your EBT account, take the following actions:

- Change your PIN by calling 866-281-2448, visiting ConnectEBT.com, or downloading the ConnectEBT mobile app (Apple App Store or Google Play Store).
- Report the theft and receive a new card by calling Virginia's EBT Client Customer Service Helpdesk at 866-281-2448, or visit one of our two City of Richmond DSS locations.
- Contact your SNAP Benefit Worker or your local non-emergency law enforcement to file a report about the stolen benefits.
