WHAT IS RVA HEALTH CORPS?

RVA Health Corps is the City of Richmond's AmeriCorps program that trains Richmond residents to serve as Community Health Workers (CHW), Peer Recovery Specialists (PRS), & Environmental Stewards. Members serve in three tracks:

- **Chronic Health Conditions:** Connect residents to resources and support for chronic diseases.
- **Environmental Stewardship:** Restore parks and public green spaces.
- **Opioid & Prescription Drug Crisis:** Provide peer recovery coaching intervention and prevention outreach services.

POSITION TYPES, LIVING ALLOWANCE AND HOURS

Three-Quarter Time (TQT)

\$17,940 / year (before taxes); \$717 bi-weekly
Approximately 1200 hrs. = (<32 hours per week)

Half-Time (HT)

\$13,260 / year (before taxes); \$530 bi-weekly
Approximately 900 hrs. = (<24 hours per week)

BENEFITS

Education Award: TQT - \$5,176.50 * HT - \$3,697.50 *

Additional Benefits: Free gym membership

** This award may be used to repay qualified student loans, current educational expenses at eligible institutions of higher education, and training programs.*
